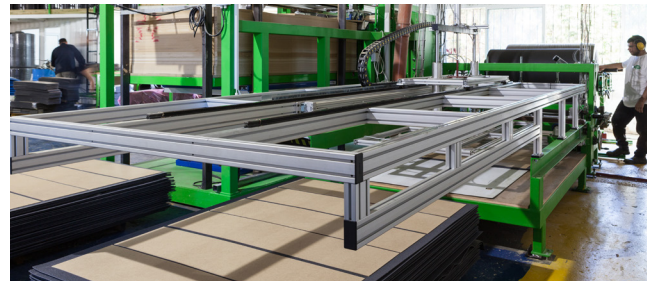




Advanced Floor Protection Sheets During Construction and Restoration Work

The building process can be very destructive, often resulting in costly damage to tiles and other flooring that is laid long before the rest of the work is concluded.

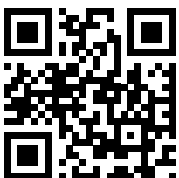

Mageneet's wide range of advanced floor protection sheets are the only products available today that are specifically designed for end-to-end protection. They provide maximum benefit and the most reliable protection at the lowest cost.

Mageneet's floor protection sheeting is made from two materials that work perfectly together: a 4mm thick layer of polyethylene closed-cell foam is bonded to a 3mm thick layer of tough wood board. The result is a highly effective product that has the advantage of both materials:

- It is hard and tough, providing effective protection against mechanical damage from falling tools, concrete particles, sharp metal scaffolding legs, etc.
- It is impenetrable to damage from liquids such as chemicals, plaster, paint, etc.
- It gently protects the flooring materials underneath while providing a stiff and safe working platform.

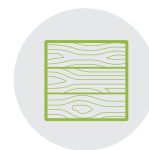
Sheetrock boards

- Expensive
- Heavy
- Expensive and complicated to haul
- Not moisture-resistant
- Installation and removal are costly and require a team of workers



Corrugated card board

- Not a reliable material
- Soaks quickly
- Very weak
- Flammable
- Unstable, especially in windy conditions
- Not an effective protector
- Prohibited for use by certain technical standards



Wood boards

- Expensive to haul and lay down
- Requires a lot of storage space
- Can be reused but depreciates quickly
- Might damage the flooring materials due to their stiffness
